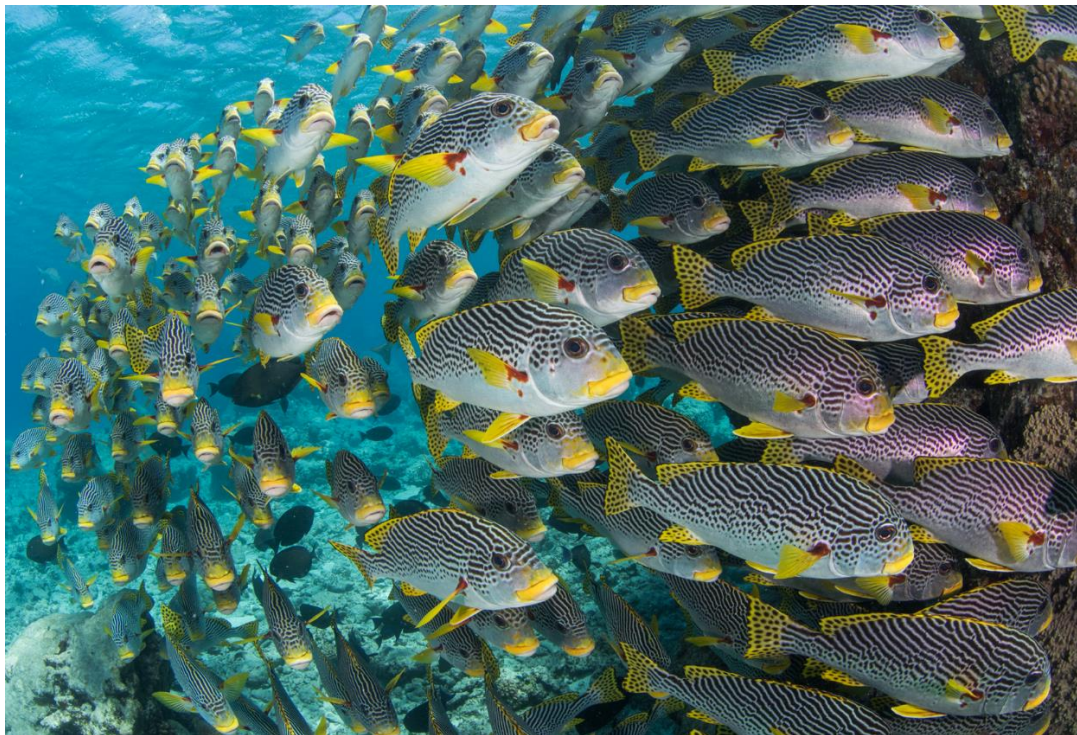

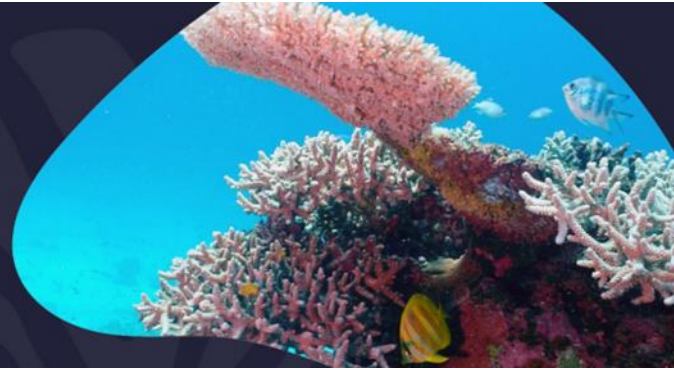
FREE- Introduction to the Great Barrier Reef webinars

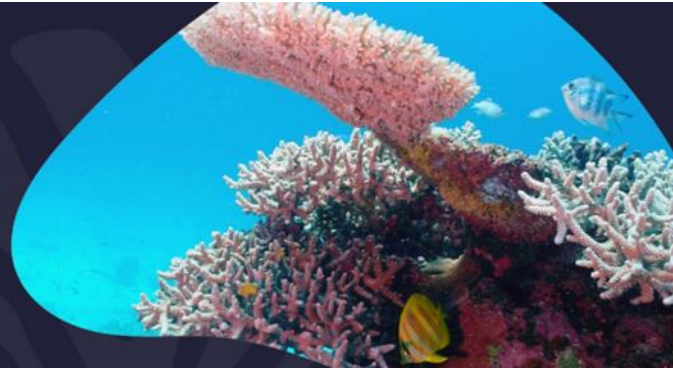
FREE – Ecosystems of the Great Barrier Reef webinars
